Note: This *Speak to Write Manual* is a combination of text and training materials. All training materials have a header at the top of the page, “Speak to Write/Training Material”. Many of the training materials are integrated into the flow of the text, but the reader should be aware that some are repetitive of text or outside of the flow. In the Table of Contents I, below, titles that are italicized are also training materials. The titles listed in this table of contents are the chapter heads, section heads, level 1 heads. This has been done to facilitate the finding of information, as there is no index. Not all the training materials are listed in this table because some of them would fall under level 2 heads or 3 heads or are repetitive of the text rather than additional information. The Table of Contents II lists all training materials in the chapters.

In addition in Chapter 7, page 124 there is a chart showing all training materials and how they were integrated into our “train the trainer” training. It may be helpful if the reader is using the training materials on their own or in a pair, for them to consult the chart and do the associated training activity (Appendix A) if there is one.

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
